

8th Annual Goats for Haiti



Well, it is spring! It's time again to be collecting donations for goats to help the needy people of Haiti. We, who are so blessed to just stop by a store and pick up a gallon of milk, find it hard to realize what it would be like to not be able to do that.

There are those living in the mountains, the poorest parts of Haiti, who do not have access to any type of milk. Not only are these goats necessary for nutrition and good health, but the goats can become a source of income for these families. They can sell extra milk, make cheese to sell, and since goats can have two or three babies yearly, they can be sold to provide more income to help raise the family above poverty.

This will be the thirteenth year that Drucie Brown and her mission team will travel to Haiti and purchase goats for the needy, and the eighth year the "*Young at Heart Sunday School Class*" has asked for your help to meet this need. We will be collection donations through the last Sunday in May. The cost of goats is still \$40.00 for one and \$75.00 for two. If you, as an individual or as a class, want to donate, you can see one of the members of the women's class or place it in the regular offering and mark it "Goats for Haiti". Any amount of donations will be appreciated. Last year you helped us raise \$1,550.00 which would have bought (38) goats.
