

## Monthly Business Meeting – Highlights and Summary of Minutes (Detailed minutes, recorded by the clerk, are located in the Secretary's Office)

The Monthly Business Meeting was held on **November 6, 2019**. Bro. Billy Compton was moderator. All the committees gave their reports. (1) The WMU are planning Lottie's Sweet Shop to benefit Lottie Moon Christmas Offering on December 15th after the Morning Worship Service. (2) Bobby Chappell, representing the Trustee Committee, reported that completion of the work on the baptristy is almost done but was delayed due to illness of the one doing the work. He also reported that they had an issue with the heating and air units recently and it was determined that 3 units need to be replaced. The Trustees are in the process of obtaining 3 bids and will report to the church once those have been obtained. (3) David England, representing the Deacons, reported that 20 Gideon Bibles (\$100) were purchased in memory of Frances Beard, upon hearing of her death recently. She was the wife of our former pastor, William R. "Bill" Beard. Bro. and Mrs. Beard served at Muldraugh Hill Baptist Church from 1950 – 1954. He also reported that the Deacon's Christmas dinner has been planned for December 5th. (4) Bro. Billy reported that the church is planning on collecting a love offering for Brookhaven Christmas gifts for the children. Information will be placed in the church bulletin in the coming weeks. Also, he reported that the GA's will be doing the Operation Christmas shoeboxes on November 17<sup>th</sup>.
